

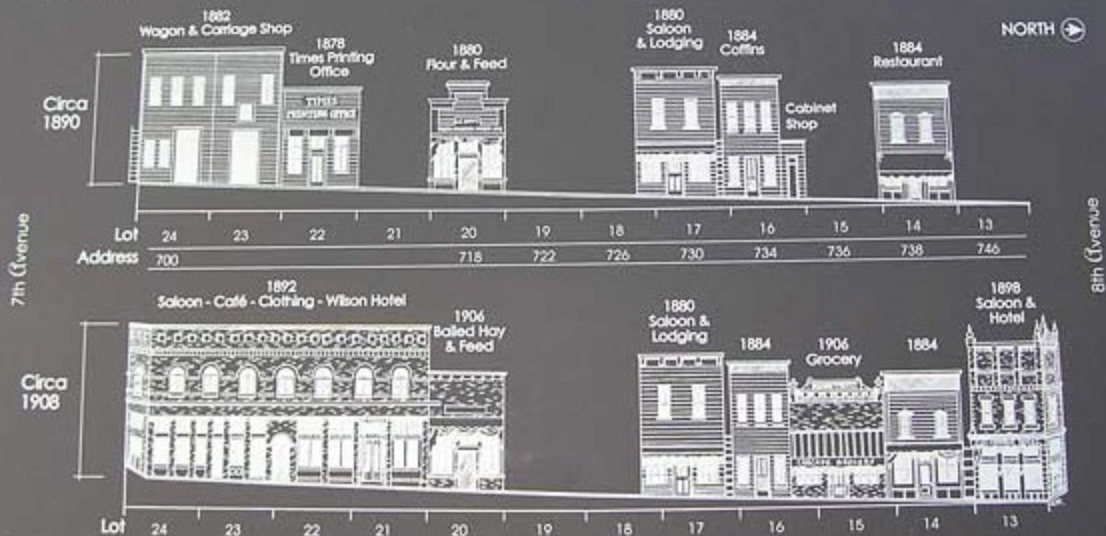
Block 9: 700 - 746 Main Street, Lots 13 - 24

Substantial brick buildings replaced wooden structures on this block by the 1890s. Louis King's two-story wagon and carriage shop dominated the south end when a wooden structure in the 1880s and as a brick beauty in the '90s. James Pierson's undertaking business, on lot 16, was Oquir's first. Both King and Pierson were talented craftsmen; King made stage coaches and carriages, Pierson created fine coffins. The artist has made every effort to accurately reproduce the structures on this block from archival photographs.
