

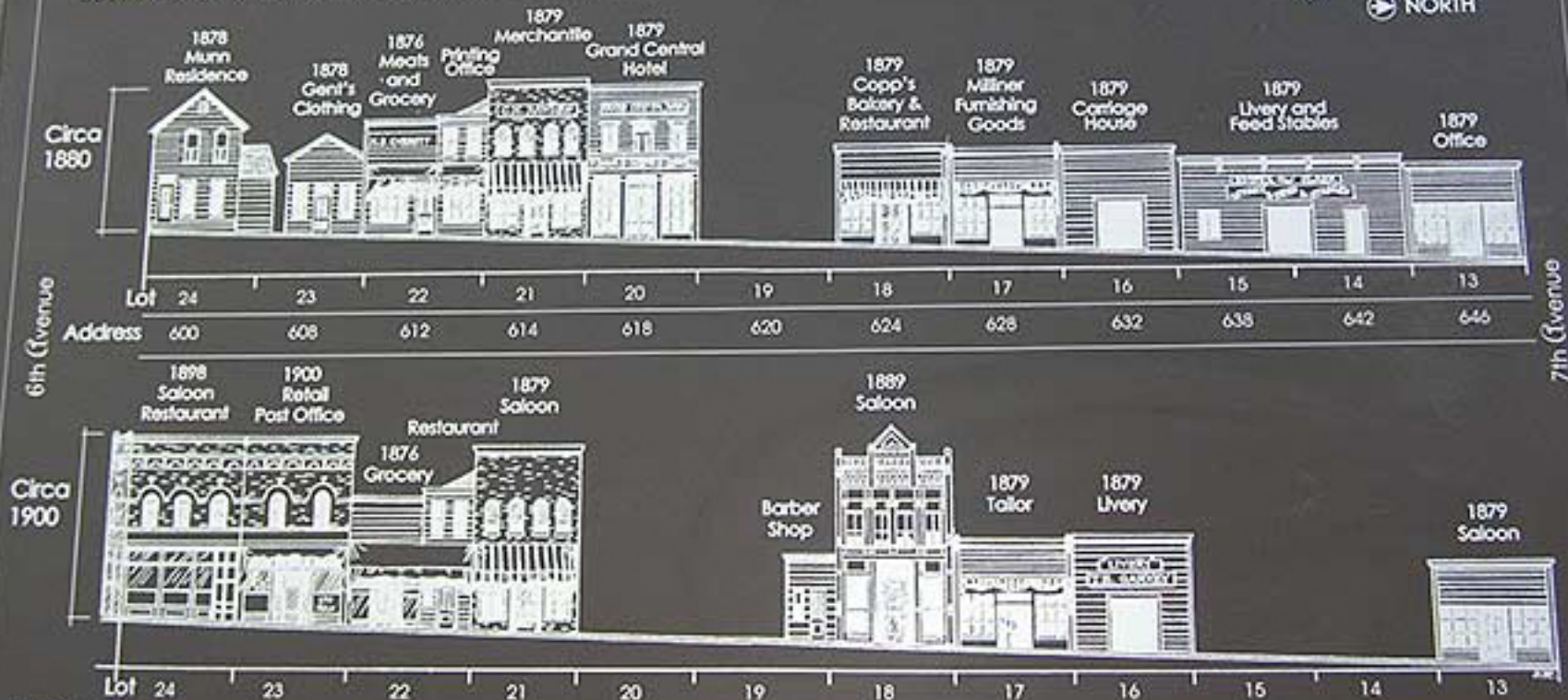
# Block 10: 600 - 646 Main Street, Lots 13 - 24

Illustrated here are two early periods of structural development on the west side of Main Street between Sixth and Seventh Avenues. Influential pioneer Ira Munn built his family home at the northwest corner of the intersection of Sixth Avenue and Main Street, where Frank Prevost later erected a handsome Queen Anne-Romanesque two-story commercial building. The Citizens State Bank moved from the Beaumont Hotel to this location in 1918. The artist has made every effort to accurately reproduce these structures from archival photographs.
