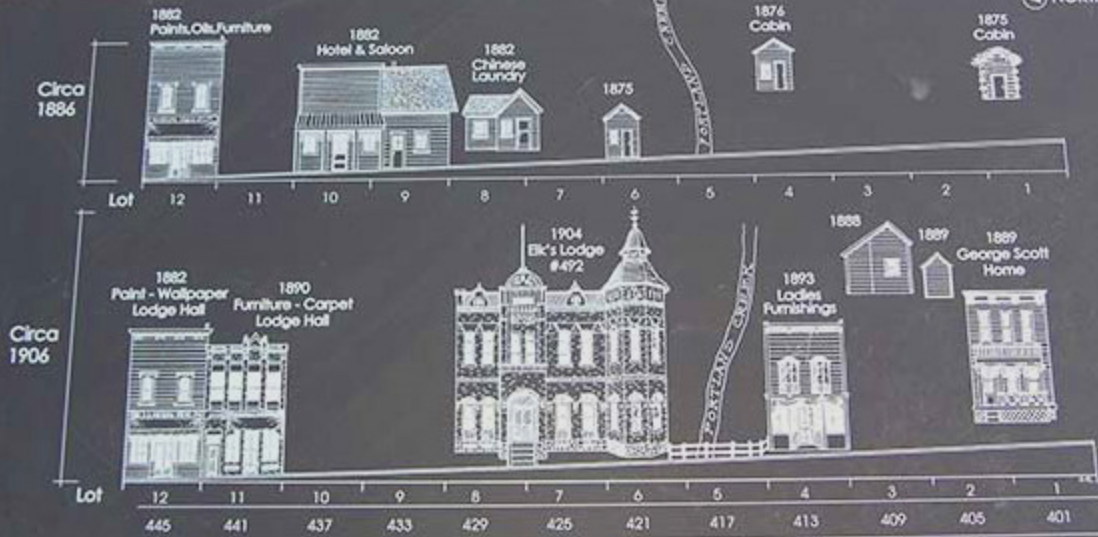


Block 20: 401 - 445 Main Street, Lots 1 - 12

Focusing on the buildings across the street, you can see much change. In 1875, George Scott, an early pioneer, built a little straw-roofed cabin on the corner lot at Main Street and 4th Avenue. Later he built a beautiful two-story home there. Several lots to the north, the unpredictable Portland Creek cut across this primitive and tenuous block descending toward the Uncompahgre River. But by 1905 substantial new structures spoke to permanence and prosperity. The artist has made every effort to accurately reproduce these structures from archival photographs.
