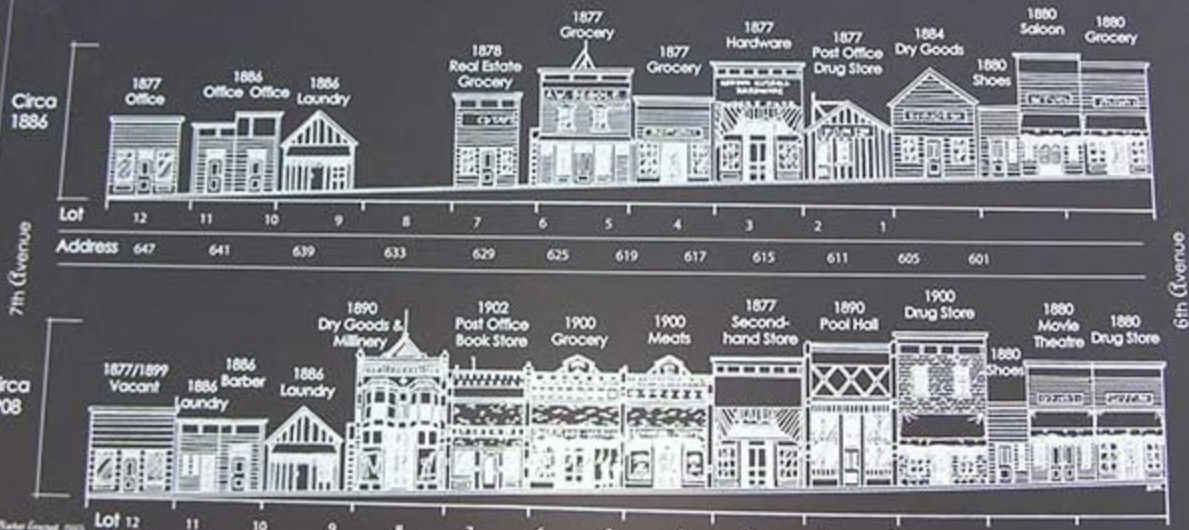


Block 18: 601 - 647 Main Street, Lots 1 - 12

Picture yourself walking along the east side of Main Street between 6th and 7th Avenues during Duray's early times. You will meet some of Duray's important businessmen. These men—Otto Meers, David Ray, and Dr. William Rowan—were also colorful characters. This block also had its share of interesting businesses in its buildings. The first, but short lived, bank in the city was established in 1877 on lot 12, and later, the first movie theatre opened its doors to the public on lot 2. The artist has made every effort to accurately reproduce this block's early structures from archival photographs.
